We will share lots of books about starting school and will talk about all of the different communities that the children belong to.



The whole class will go for a walk around our school community, looking at the whole school environment and meeting adults that work here.

Children will talk about their walk around the school and recall who people are and what happens in the different rooms around the school.

Children will make a 'Marvellous Me' board showing what things they like to do, who is in their family and any pets that they have. They will share these with friends and look at the similarities and differences.
