This project teaches children about how they have grown and changed since they were babies and how life in the past was different from today.



We will look at photographs of us when we were babies and think about how we have changed over time. We will discuss what we can do now that you couldn't do when you were a baby.

We find out why the photographs taken in the past are in black and white. We will take photographs of each other and edit them into black and white photographs.

We will look at pictures of objects from the past and try to work out what they were used for. We will think about the modern day equivalent and imagine what it was like to live in the past. We will learn how some things have changed over time.
