


# Y5/6: Autumn 1: Knowledge Organiser: What does it mean if God is Holy and Loving?

Old Testament	The Old Testament is the part of the bible that tells the story of the relationship between God and people before the arrival of Jesus.	Key Knowledge	
holy	exalted or worthy of complete devotion as one perfect in goodness and righteousness (freedom from guilt or sin)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>★ Christians believe that God is all-powerful and all-knowing</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>★ Christians believe that God loves them in a similar way to a parent loving a child</li> </ul>
altar	the table in a Christian church at which the bread and wine are consecrated in communion services	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>★ Christians try to act in ways that they believe will please God - they use the bible to learn what these might be</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Churches and cathedrals have features that reflect Christian beliefs about God - such as stained glass windows that tell stories, the altar where the communion is prepared and (in Catholicism) the confessional where people admit and say sorry for sins.</li> </ul>
sacred	devoted or dedicated to a deity (god) or to some religious purpose	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The Ten Commandments are a list of rules that Christians believe was given by God to Moses</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The Psalms of David are songs and poems written in praise of God by the Jewish king, David in the Old Testament. David was the king, who, as a young shepherd boy, defeated the giant Goliath with a slingshot.</li> </ul>
psalm	A sacred song or poem often used in worship		
cathedral	A large and important church which contains a bishop's chair
