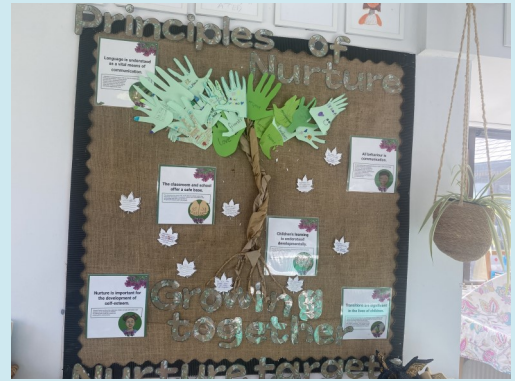

NURTURE

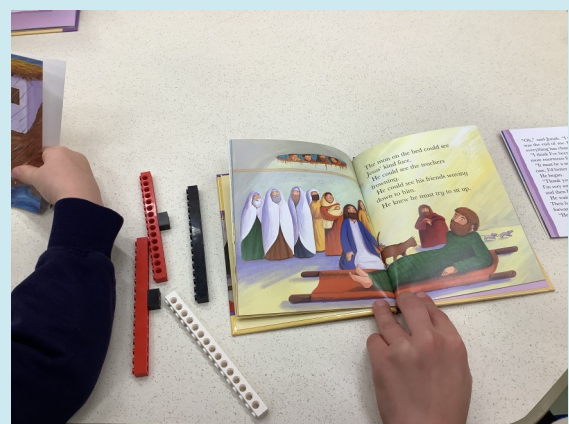
